

Building With Care





The New Testament describes the church as a beautiful bride on

the one hand, and a work in progress on the other. Both realities require a response to the gospel and a willingness to let God finish the work he has begun in our lives, individually and as the church.

In 1 Corinthians 3, Paul describes the church in Corinth as a building, and states that the leader's job is to build with care. And often that care is expressed in using the right materials and tools for the job. Many churches struggle, not because their leaders don't care, but because they don't have access to the necessary materials or tools to do their work in the best ways.

The goal of MB Seminary is to come alongside and train leaders, provide good material when needed, and to make sure each builder has the right tools in their Christian ministry toolbox.

Coming alongside in some cases can mean laying the foundation and working from the ground up. Some people come to seminary not long after they have been called to follow Christ, and they have just begun their training and educational journey. Others come well into their life of service in the church or elsewhere and need the seminary to add to their toolbox or refine their building plans.

MB Seminary is the national seminary of the MB Churches of Canada and is positioned well to answer your training and leadership needs.

As 2017 comes to a close in a few weeks, please consider a gift before December 31.
